## Infield Tryout -

- A. No runners on base 15 Minutes
  - 1. Ground balls to various infielders
    - a. Base umpire Angle/Distance at 1<sup>st</sup> base
    - b. Plate umpire Follow up the 1<sup>st</sup> baseline
- B. Runner on  $1^{st}$  base 15 Minutes
  - 1. Double plays
    - a. Base umpire footwork
    - Plate umpire front end of the double play observing slides helping on back-end for pulled foot/swiped tag
- C. Runners on  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  and Runners on  $1^{st}$  and  $3^{rd} 15$  minutes
  - 1. Double plays
  - 2. Multiple plays in the infield
  - 3. Single to right field
    - a. Base umpire Working area and then moving to a secondary play

b. Plate umpire communicating, "I've got  $3^{rd!}$ " initially and then "I've got  $3^{rd!}$ " When the play develops at third or "Going home!" if no play develops at  $3^{rd}$ .

- 4. Double steals
  - a. Communicating for rundowns.
